Given that teachers are busy and data examination can be time-consuming, this session invites participants to engage and explore the new free online MDTP assessment tool. This assessment tool streamlines the process of capturing data of your current student’s mathematical strengths, common misconceptions, and achievement gaps. Knowledge from this data can be used to launch mathematical tasks that shift your instruction to meet the needs of your students.

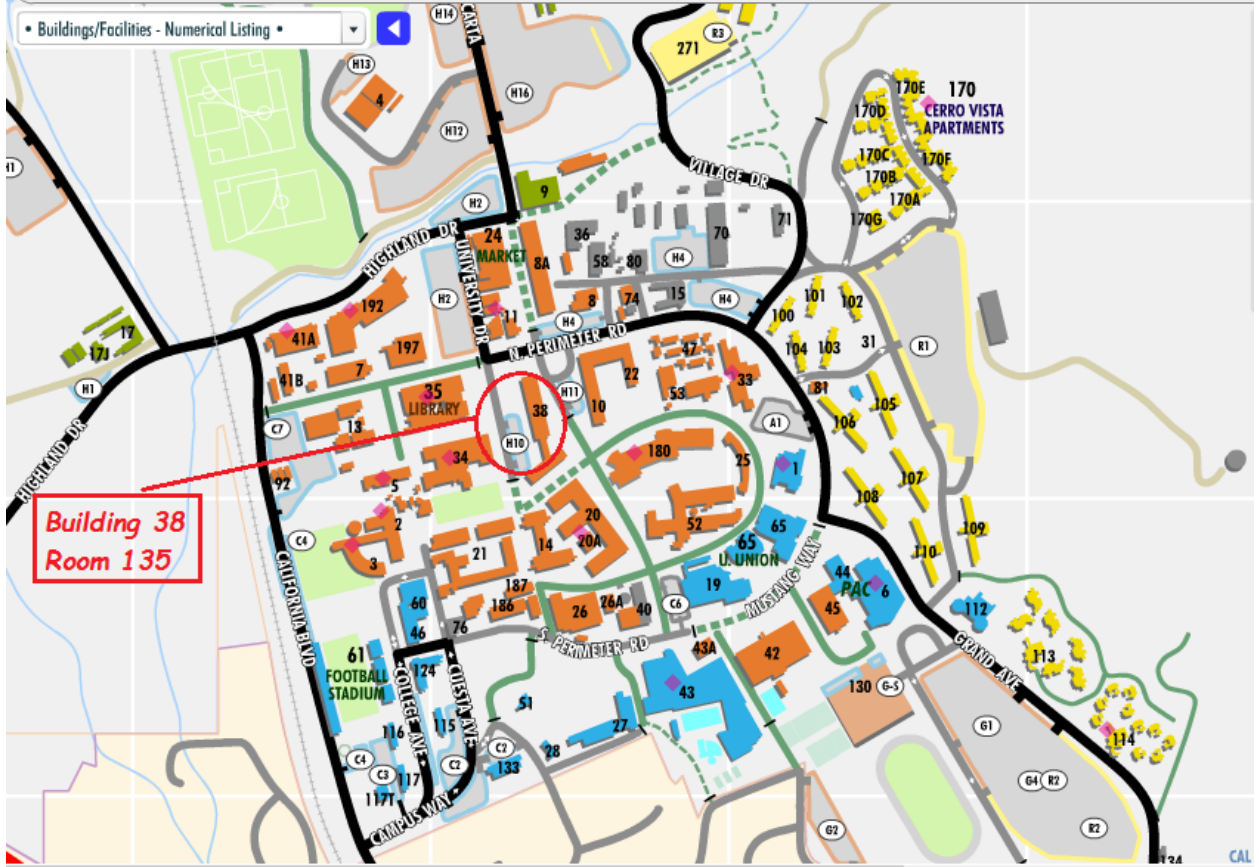
