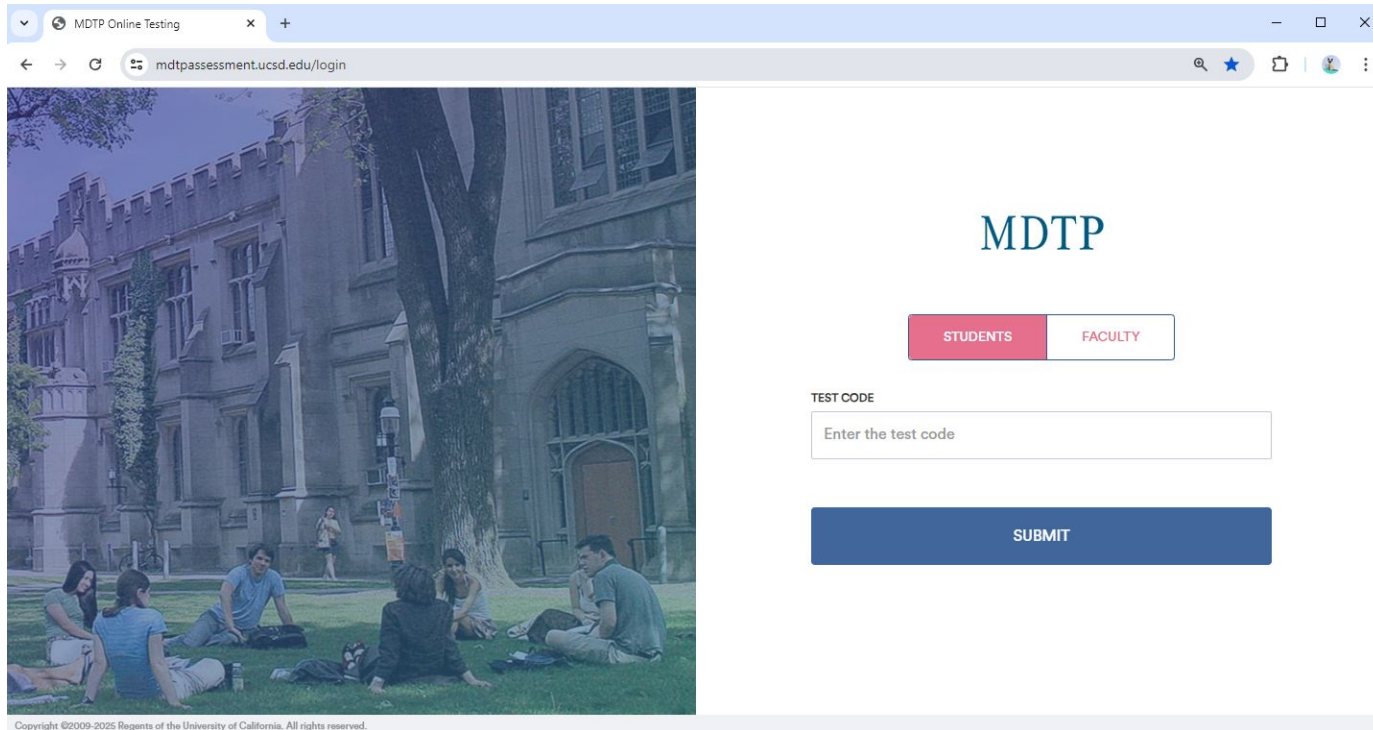


## Students Entering and Exiting a Test

3) The information students will enter will depend on the type of class registration selected when creating the class:

3. All scratch paper must be turned in when the test is finished.
4. For the best test results, you should not guess. If you cannot answer a question, leave it blank.
5. Skip a question that you are spending too much time answering. You may return to skipped questions at anytime during the test.

5) Students may navigate the test using the “**Next**” and “**Previous**” buttons or by selecting the test question number. If a time limit was specified, the “**Time Remaining**” will be shown.

7) Students can keep track of their test progress by referring to the list of test questions at the top and the summary provided at the top right of the screen.

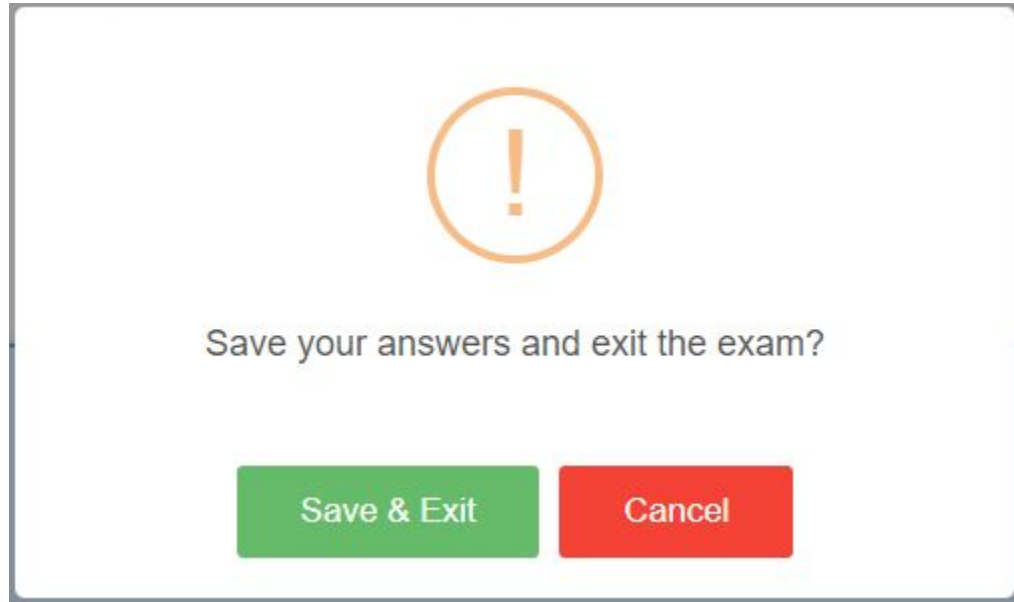
8) On the last question of the test students can select the “**Finish**” button to save and exit the test.

9) A popup will appear notifying students that they are about to exit the exam.

- a. Select “**Save & Exit**” to submit answers and exit the test.
- b. Select “**Cancel**” to return to the exam.



10) If **“Save & Exit”** is selected, a window will appear with a test summary. Selecting **“Logout”** will exit the test and redirect the student back to the login screen.
